PREPARATION

Choose one topic from the list below and be prepared to give a short presentation on it for about three minutes. In the test, you will also answer questions and join in a discussion on your topic and the topic of the other student.

THE TEST WILL BE LIKE THIS:

Task 1: 2-4 minutes: Introductory warm-up.

The examiner will ask you to introduce yourself and say a little about who you are, what you like doing and so on. Be prepared to ask the other student questions about his/her hobbies, ambitions and so on.

Task 2: 8-10 minutes: Prepared discussion.

You and the other student will each give your three-minute presentation in turn. You should then be prepared to engage in a discussion about your chosen topics.

Task 3: about 8 minutes: Unprepared discussion.

You will be given a task to complete with the other student. You will both be given some information or facts and by negotiation and discussion you must make some decisions together about your priorities.
