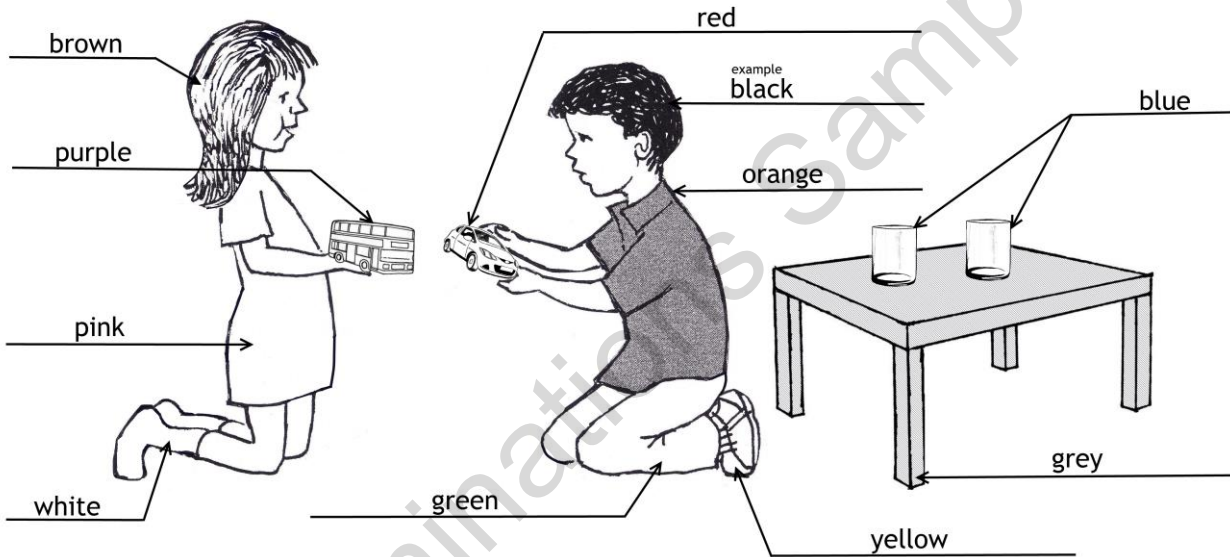
Section D (10 marks – 2 marks for each correct answer, either letter or word)

3. (birthday) day and month necessary, ignore presence or absence of year.
4. Any month of the year acceptable, 1 for recognisable month, there may be misspelling, messy writing, 2 for perfect month word.
5. Any fruit acceptable, as above.
